

Deleting Fabrics from the Library

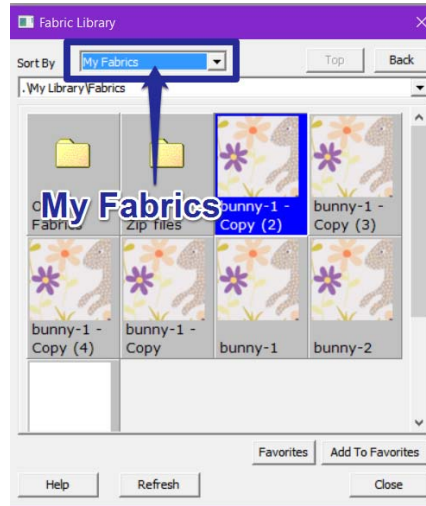

Sometimes the fabric we scan doesn't look right and we try again and again. The end result is that we end up with multiple copies of the same fabric in the My Fabrics section of the Fabric Library.

In order to make it easy to choose the correct fabric when designing, we should delete the bad copies of the file.

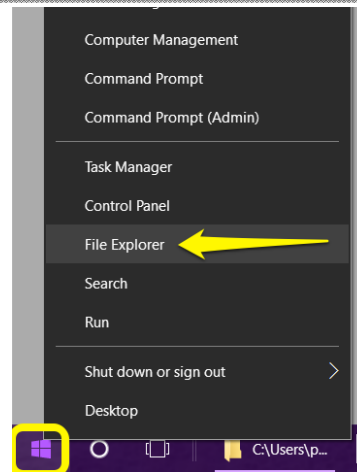
Deleting Fabric files is best done through Windows's File Explorer.



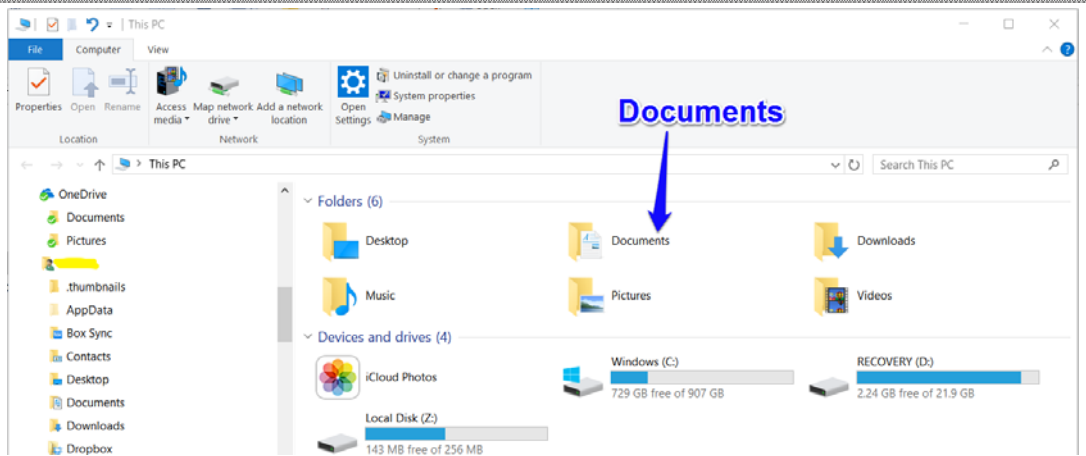
Please Note: We do not recommend deleting fabric files from the Quilt-Pro Program Files folder.

Start by right-clicking the **Start** button on the lower left of your screen.

Click **File Explorer**



Locate and double-click **Documents**

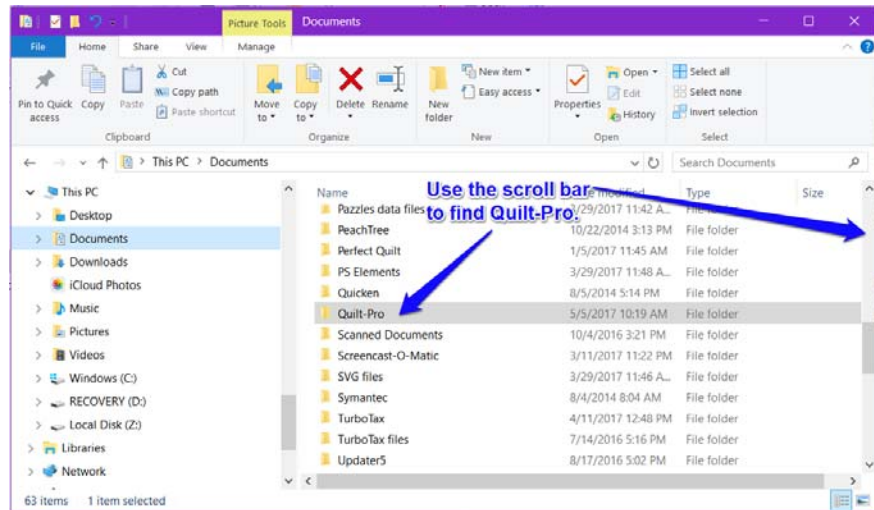

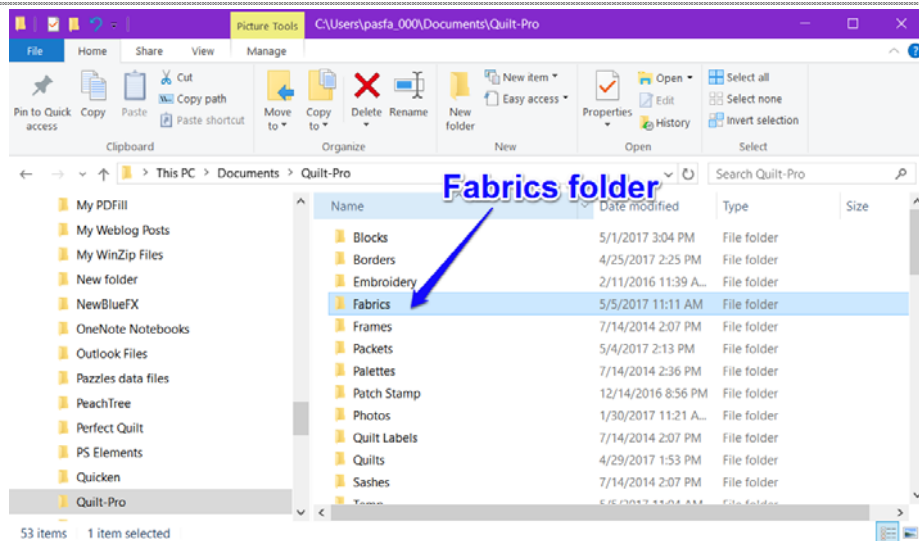
Quilt-Pro 6

Use the scroll bar to locate Quilt-Pro, it will be in alphabetical order.

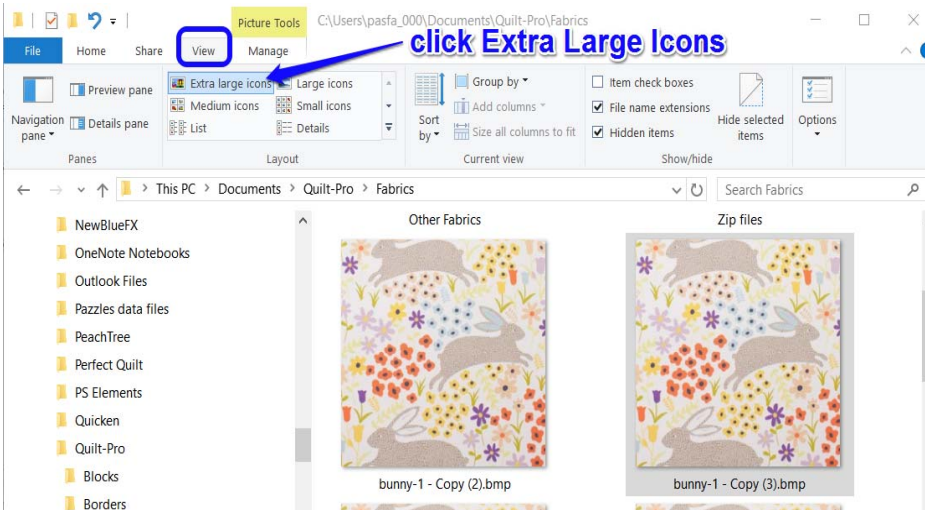
Double click to open it.



Double click to open the Fabrics folder.



Once in the Fabrics folder, if the images are small or show only the file names, click the View tab and select Extra Large Icons

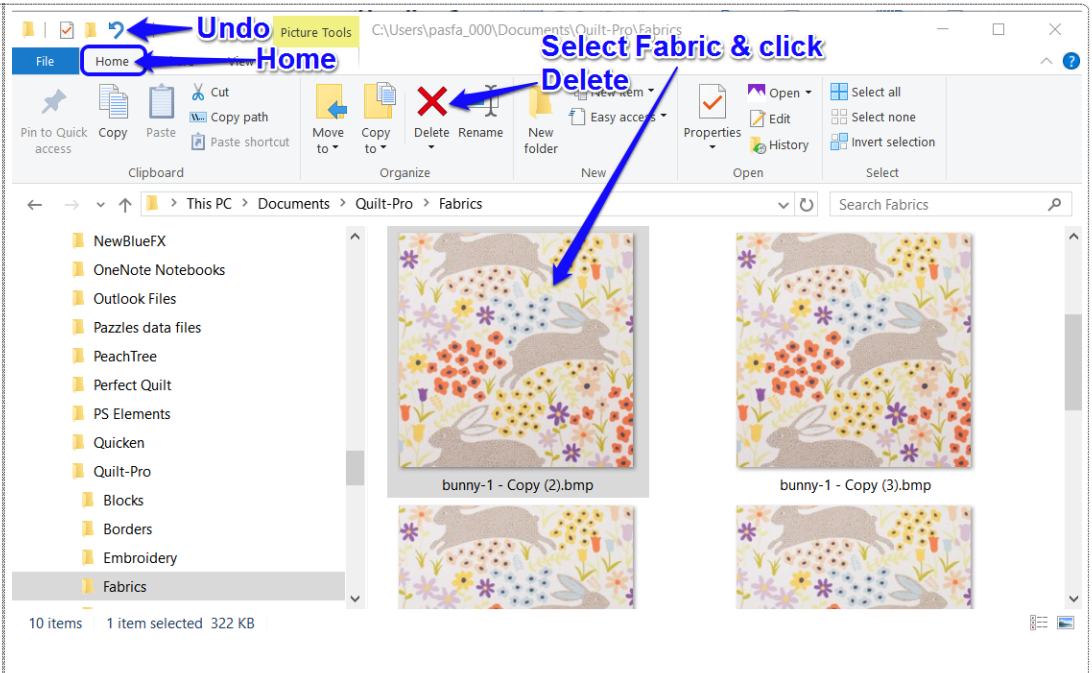

Next click the **Home** tab, select the fabric to delete and click the Red **X**, which is the **Delete** button.

If you chose the wrong fabric to delete, use the **Undo** button to restore the file.

That's it, once all the files are gone that you wanted gone, you may close the File Explorer.
