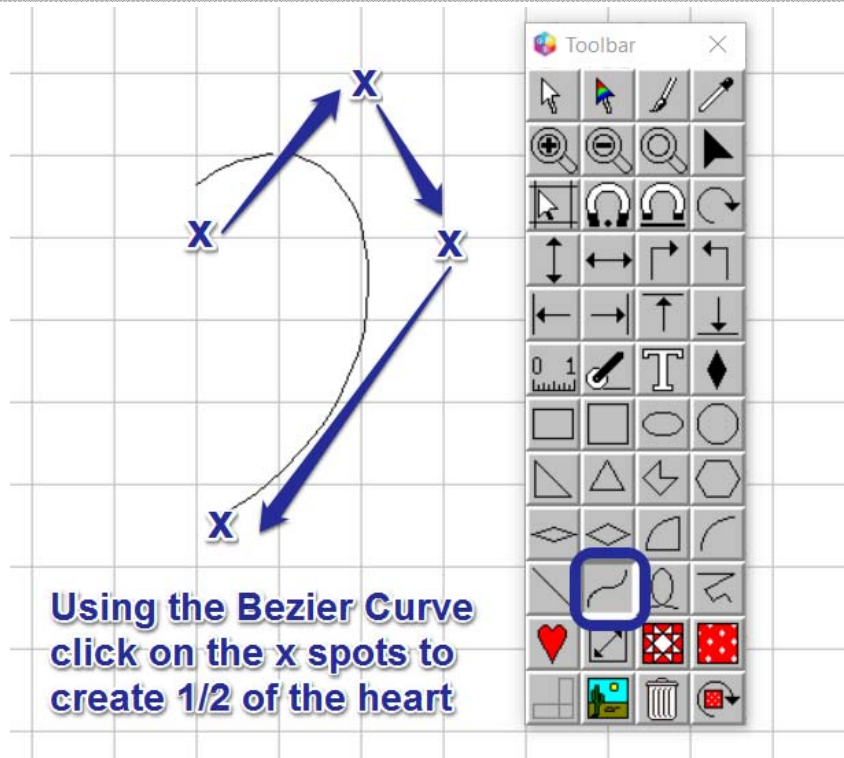


Easy Heart Stencil Quilt-Pro 6

To draw the heart shape, unselect the Snap to Grid button.

Using the Bezier Curve to draw 1/2 of the heart shape.

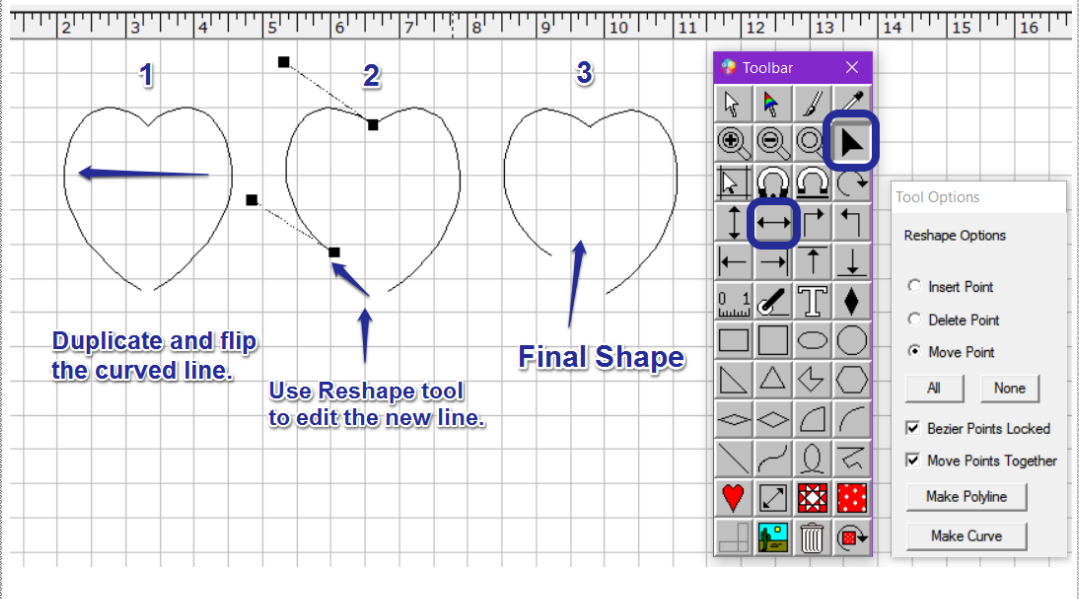
Use the reshape tool to adjust the shape to your liking. (see next step)



Select the curved line and use the **Edit** menu, **Duplicate**. Then Select the new curve and use the **Flip Horizontal** tool to flip the line to create a heart shape, with the lines at the top meeting but it is not necessary that the lines at the bottom meet.

Press the **Reshape** tool and click the left side line to edit it's shape. Then select the bottom black box and move the box up and slightly to the left.

The shape should look similar to the final shape in the image.



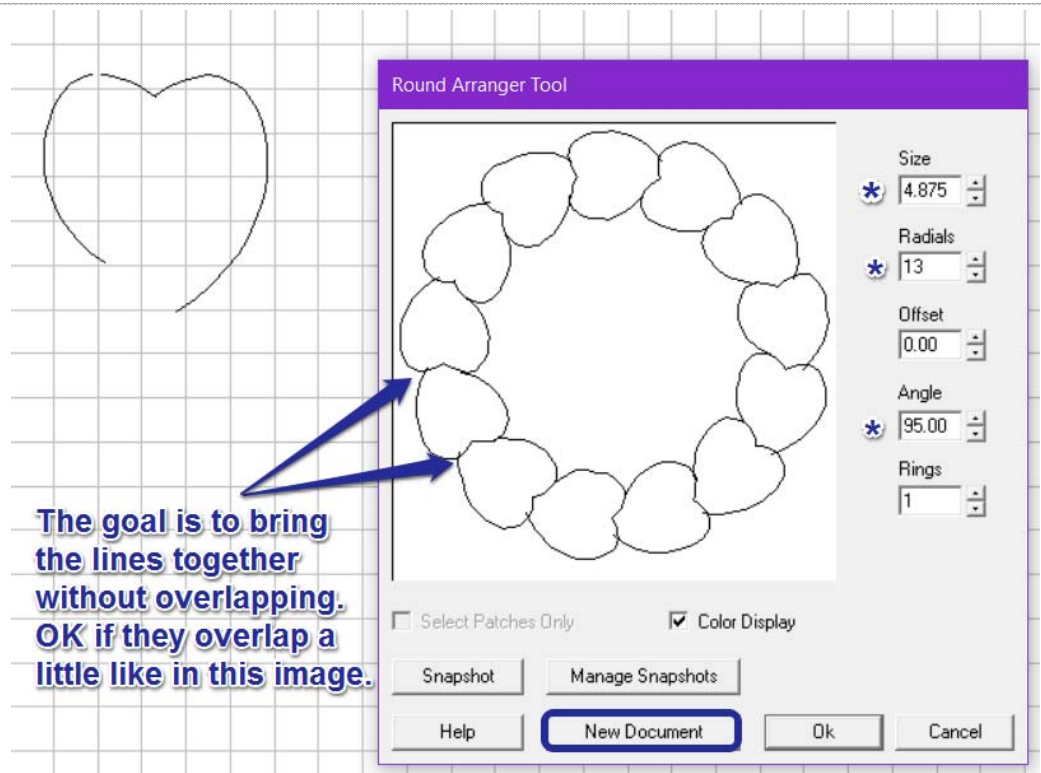

Click the Effect menu and choose Round Arranger.

These are the initial settings to use but you may have to fine tune them to work with your heart shape.

Size: 4.875
Radials: 13
Offset: 0
Angle: 95.00
Rings: 1

When you are happy with the result, click **New Document**.



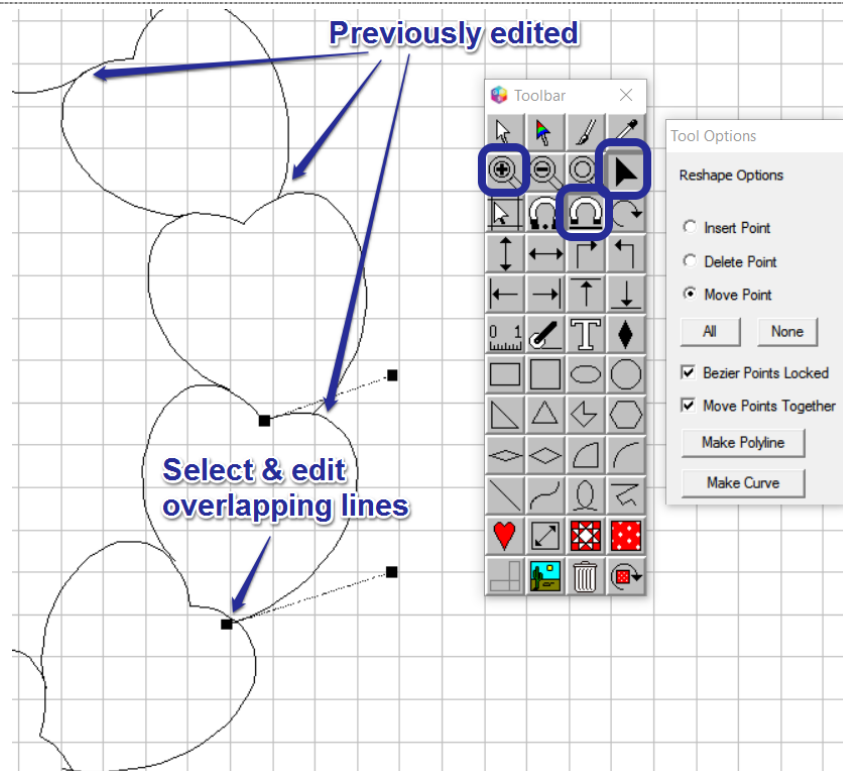
Click the Zoom in tool to make it easier to edit the lines.

Next, click on **Snap to Line** so that the edited line lines with the line closest to it.

Select the **Reshape** tool and click on one of lines that need correcting.

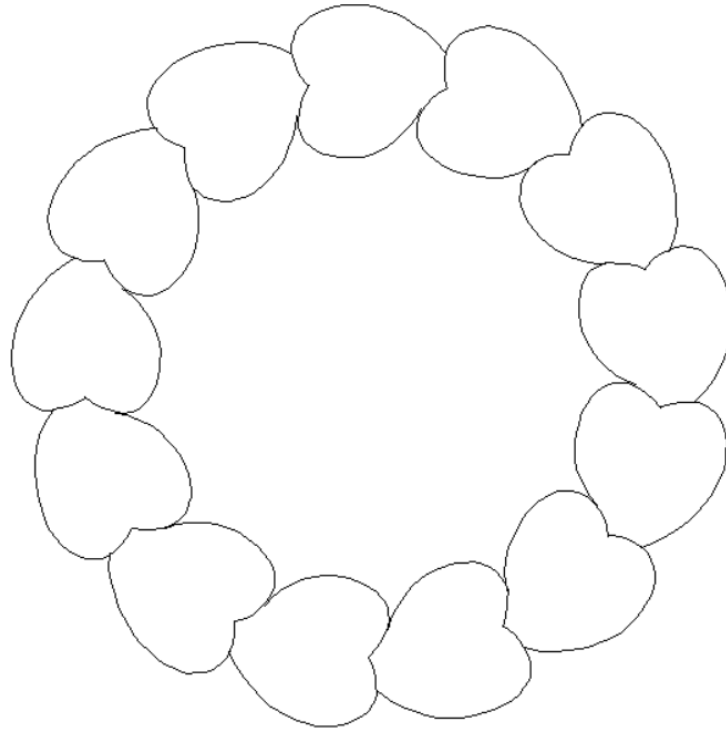
When you are happy with the stencil, save it for use on a quilt project.

When you use the block library, sort to My Blocks.



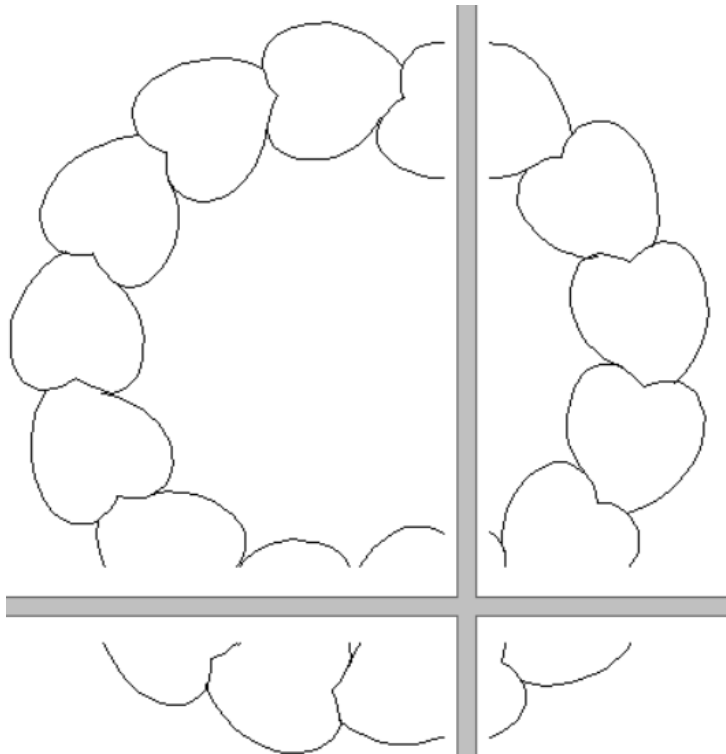

To print the design, click the **File** menu, **Print Center** and then click **Print Block**.



If you choose to print the design larger than the page size, click **Multiple Pages** option. The print out will look like the image.

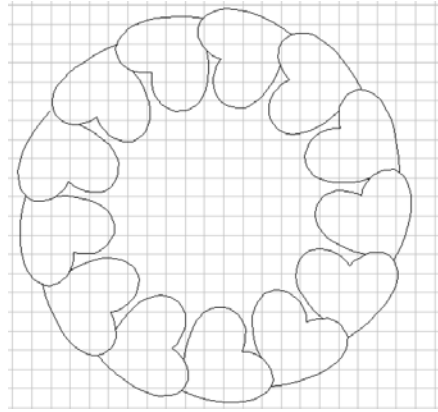
Tape sheets together to get a complete pattern.



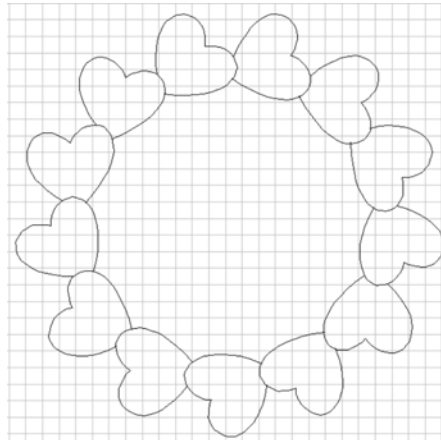

Other options:

A slight increase in the angle setting, to 120, creates this design.



A large increase in the Angle setting, to 300, creates this design. Small adjustment to the Size setting may be necessary.



The Heart Stencil in the quilt.

Enable Layer setting in the Quilt Wizard and add the design to the Stencil layer.
