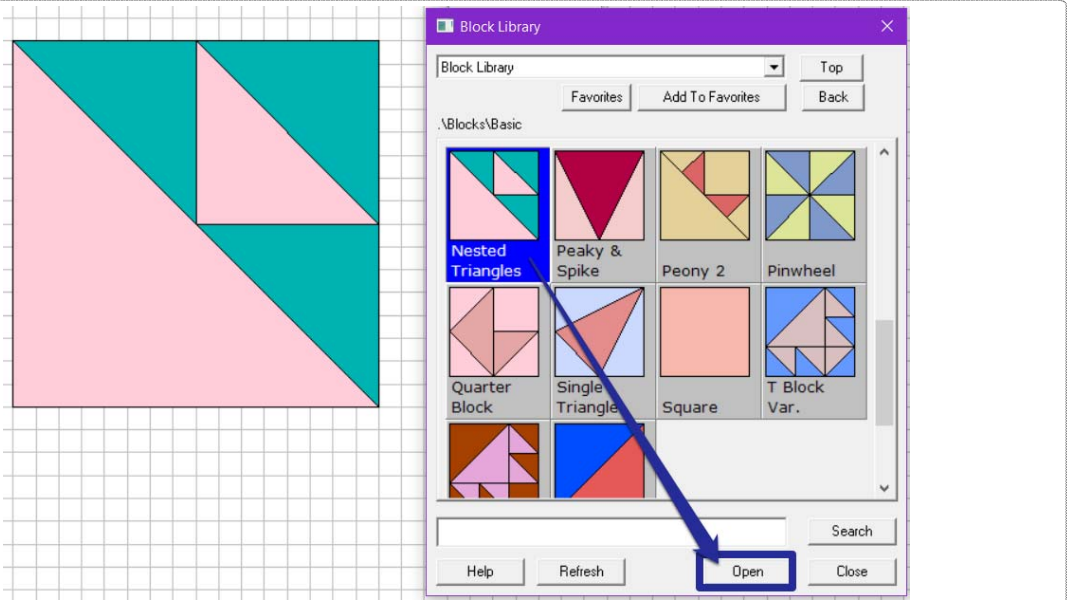


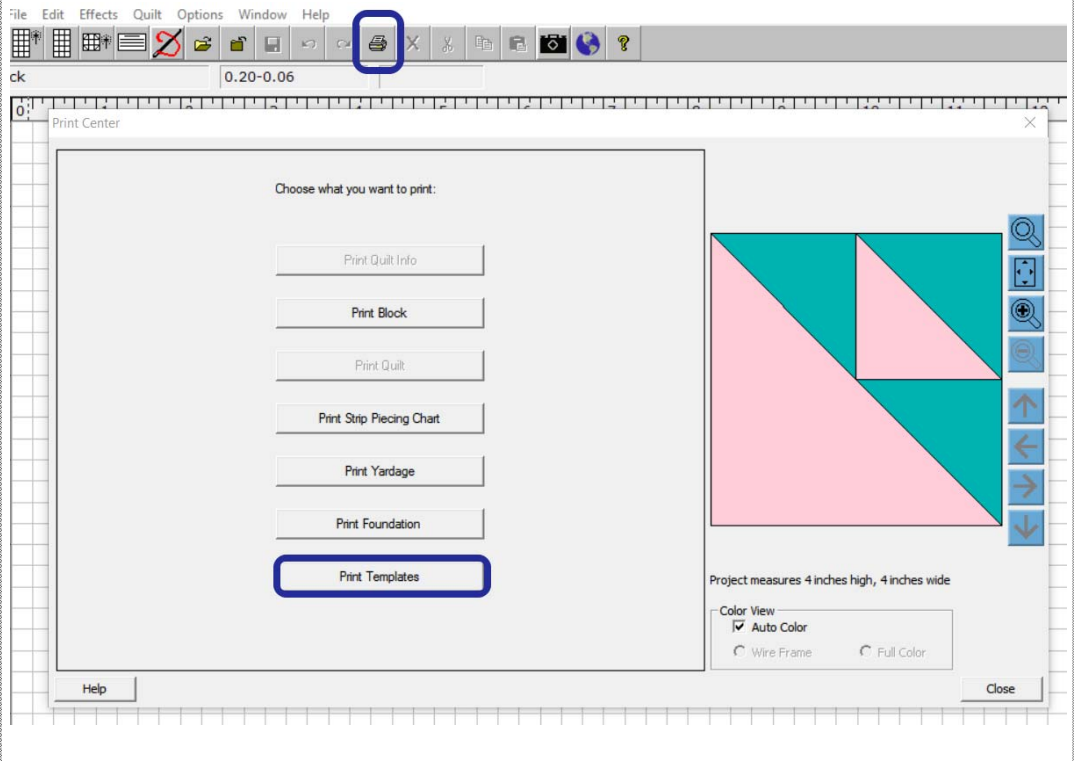
## Quilt-Pro 6

If you're a quilting teacher or pattern designer you might need or want to add more information to the templates you're printing for your instructions. Or maybe you're just a regular quilter who doesn't want to have to look at the computer to determine how many triangles to cut from a certain fabric.

For this lesson we'll be using the **Album Block** from the **Basics** folder in the **Block Library**.



Click the **Printer** button on the **Ribbon bar** to open the **Print Center**. (Or choose **File** menu, **Print Center**)

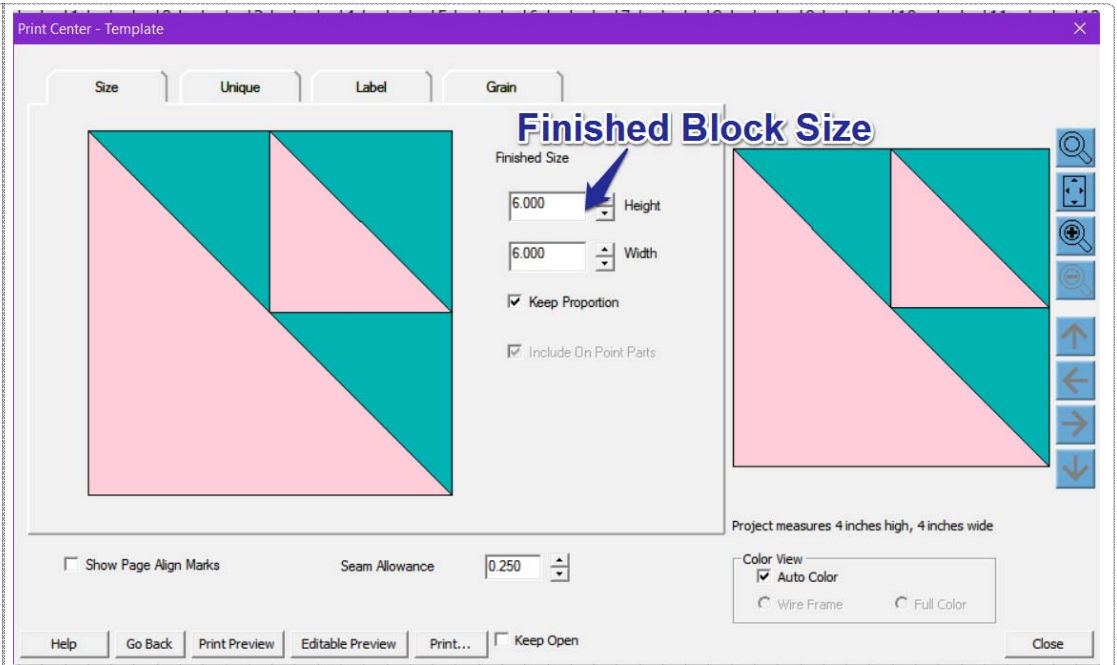


Then click **Print Templates** button

## Quilt-Pro 6

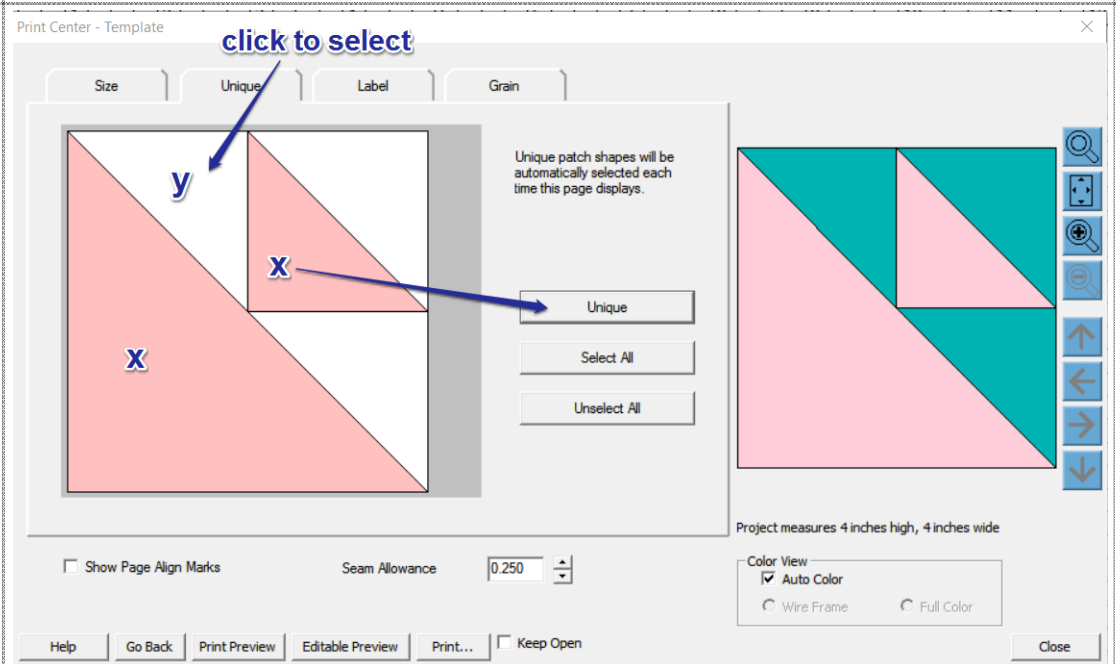
In the **Size** tab, change the **Finished Size** to 6.00"

Note: **Finished Size** is the size of the block after it is sewn to the surrounding blocks, borders, etc. Stated more simply, the size you select should not include the seam allowance.



When you click the **Unique** tab, the unique patch shapes will automatically be selected. In this image, the unique patches are highlighted in pink, and marked with an X, and will be the patches labeled and printed.

Even though the two small triangles marked x and y are the same size, they should be cut from different fabrics and the end user may not realize that when using the templates. So we will be adding the patch marked with a y to this set of patches to be printed. Click on the patch to select it.



# Editing Template Labels

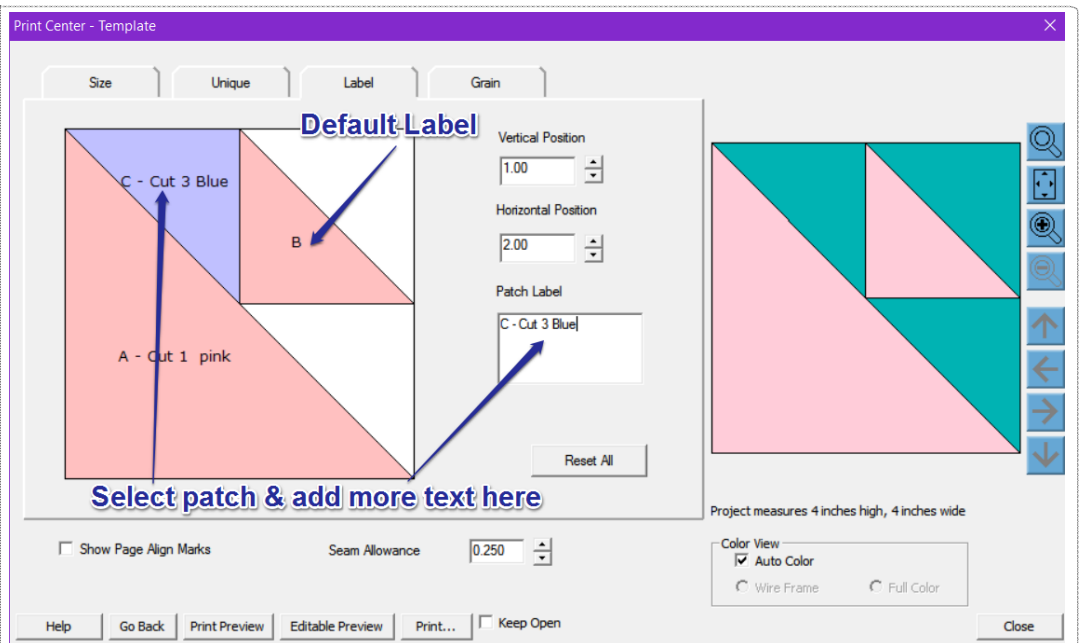


## Quilt-Pro 6 -

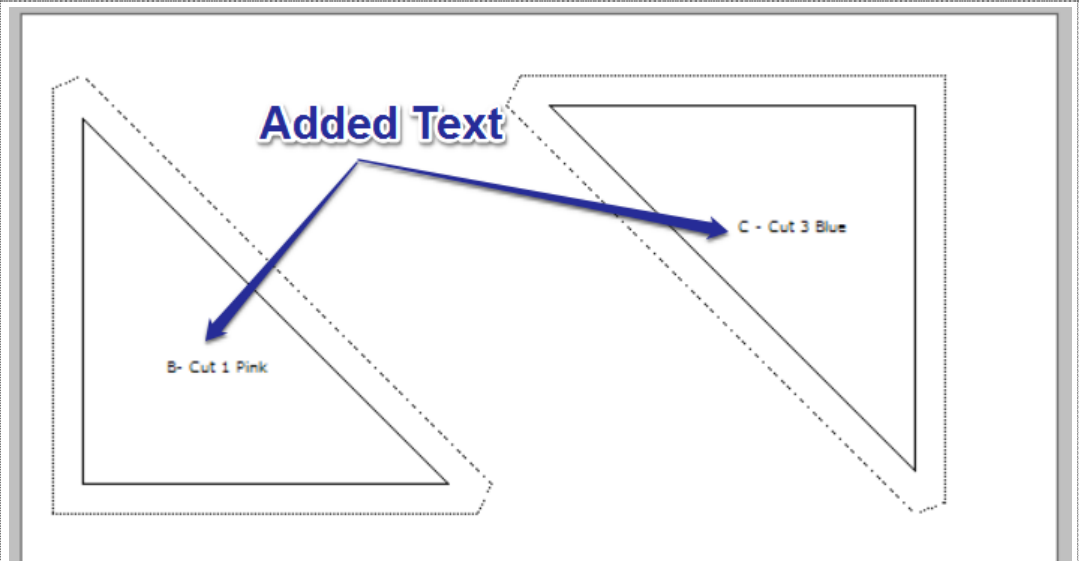
Now click the **Label** tab and select the patches and add your instruction to the **Patch Label** box.

**Note:** Please limit the amount of text added as the label will not wrap to a second line.

If your additional text is causing the label to overlap the adjacent label use the **Vertical and Horizontal Position** setting to adjust.



Click Print preview to see the templates.
