

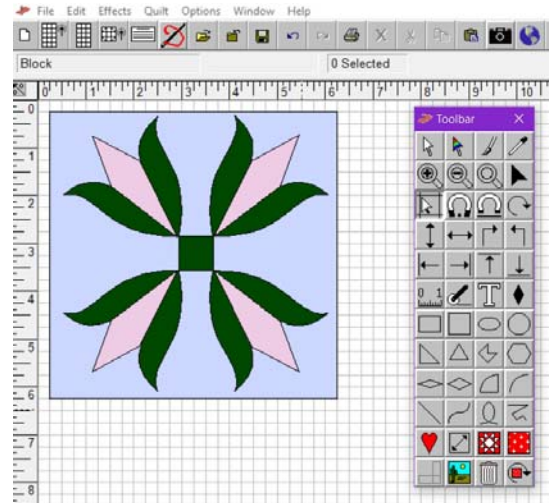
Quilt-Pro 6 - Using Selected Patches to create a new block with Round Arranger

The Round Arranger duplicates and arranges patches in a circle. However, instead of creating new patches to use, you may select patches from a previously created block found in the block library. This quick lesson builds on the more detailed Round Arranger lesson found by clicking [here](#).

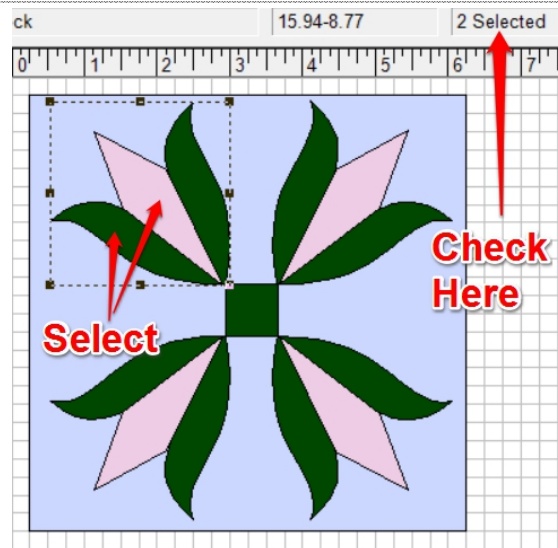
Open the **Block Library** and select the **Applique** folder.

Locate and open the **Traditional Applique** Folder.

Scroll down the list and select the **Tulip Quilt** Block and press the **Open** Button.



Press and hold the Shift Key on your Keyboard and click the two patches using the **Select Arrow** as indicated.



Release the shift key and use **Effects** menu, **Round Arranger**.

Size: 4.125

Radials: 10

Offset: 30

Angle: 45

Play with the settings. Once you've found the arrangement you like, click the **New Document** button. Remember to add your background patch and save.
