

Quilt-Pro 6 - Rotating a Log Cabin Block

Rotating blocks is an easy way to transform the look of your Log Cabin quilt. In this lesson, we will use the Rotate Right tool.

Use the **Rotate Right** Tool to rotate the block clockwise 90 degrees.



Use the **Rotate Left** Tool to rotate the block counter-clockwise 90 degrees.



Let's start this lesson by closing out all other projects and creating a new quilt using these settings.

Open the **Quilt Wizard** by clicking the **Quilt Wizard** button on the **Ribbon bar**.



In the **Layout** tab, choose **Layout Type: Straight Blocks**

In the **Size** tab, set the **Blocks down** and **Blocks Across** to: 6

Block Size: Block Width and Height: 6"

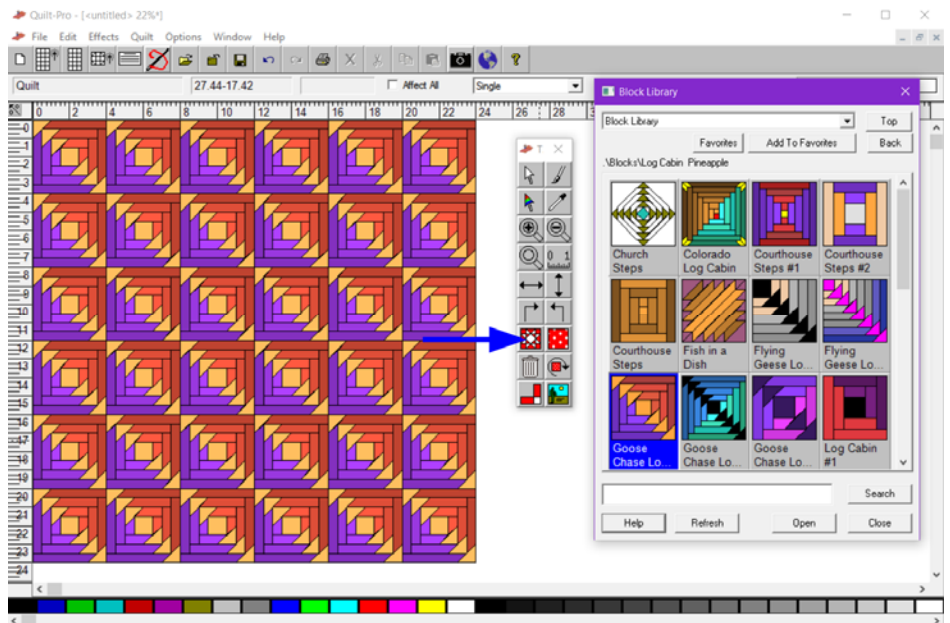
Click the **Finish** button.

Click the **Block Library** button on the toolbar.



Scroll down the list until you find the **Log Cabin & Pineapple** folder. Open the folder.

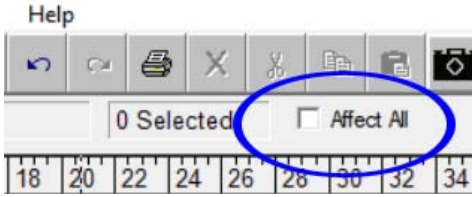
Scroll down and select the **Goose Chase Log Cabin #1**. Move the cursor to the quilt and click once to fill the quilt with the block. Close the Block Library.

Now we will rotate a few blocks to change the design.

Remove the checkmark from the **Affect All** option on the status bar.



Using the **Rotate Left** tool, click on the marked blocks as many times as indicated.



This is the end result of all that rotating.

Save the quilt using **File, Save As...**
